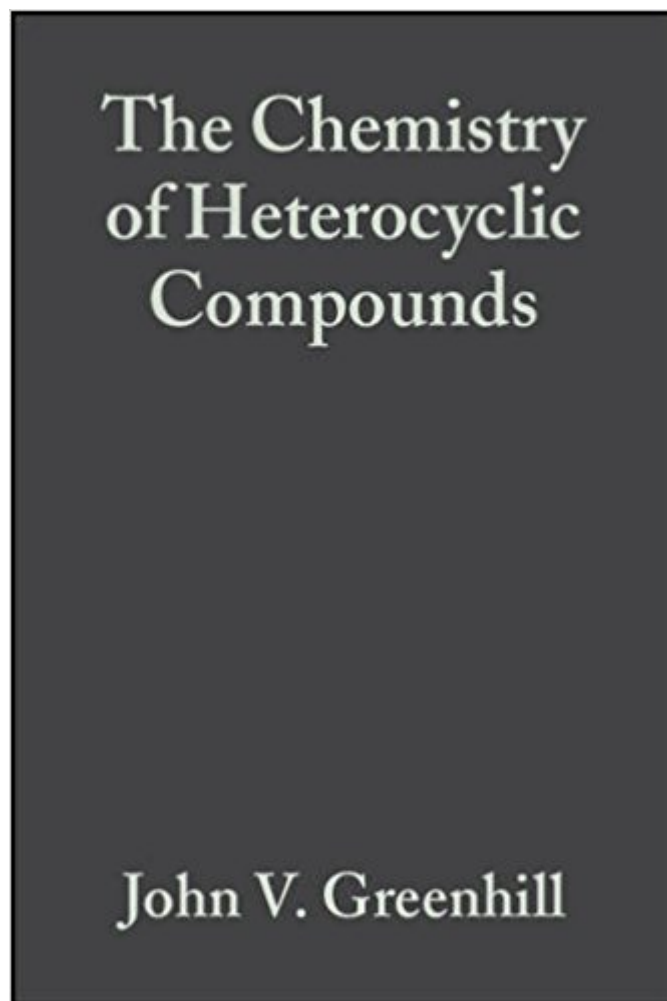


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# Quinolines, Part 3 (The Chemistry Of Heterocyclic Compounds, Vol. 32)
