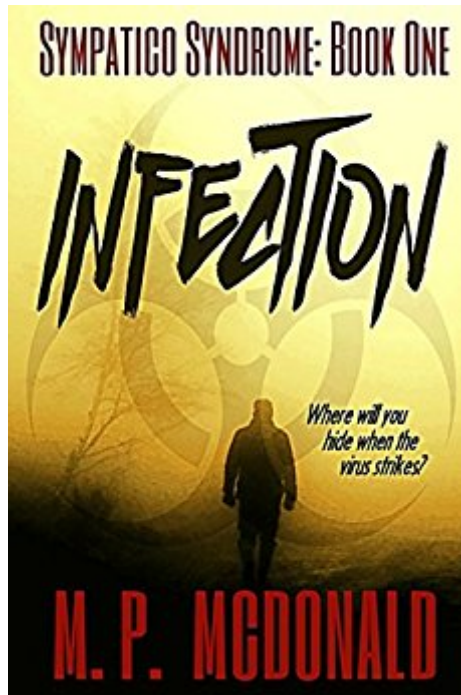


The book was found

I enjoyed this book. I, like the author have always been interested in medical matters and thoroughly enjoyed my college microbiology class. This book is in a way similar to "The Stand" by Stephen King and "Outbreak" by Robin Cook in that they all deal with unknown biological outbreaks of new

diseases that are catastrophic to mankind. This story goes a little deeper into how to prevent being infected by the virus. It follows the family of Cole Evans as they try to get to an island Cole owns in Lake Michigan. Cole and his brother's family have an easier time of it than his son Hunter who is at college in Colorado when the virus begins to spread. Therefore it follows Hunter more closely after the remaining family reaches the island. This book is well written and has good pacing, but ends rather abruptly. There is a sufficient amount of details describing the action and sufficient dialogue. I will look for the next installment when it is published, hopefully early 2017.

This author's creativity is brilliant! The disease he has created is like no other that I have read thus far. So refreshing it has been to find something original in this pandemic apocalyptic genre. The writing is superb, characters are believable as is the whole story line, God forbid! I will be anxiously awaiting book two that is due to be released sometime next year. Early in the year, I hope. I was riveted, totally engrossed, during the whole book. Finding I was reaching the end, I suddenly realized time had flown by and I had read the whole book in one sitting. My stiff limbs, numb bum, and kinked neck were well worth it. Storyline in this one is that some kind of engineered virus has escaped from a bio lab and ravaged the world. A handful of people manage to survive. The story focuses on a family and some friends and acquaintances that managed to make it to an island in Lake Michigan. The author has

done some superficial research on a lot of issues that might come up were such an event to happen. Unfortunately the research is lacking in spots and it makes the story a little implausible at points. It's still pretty good and is usually the case with this kind of story you kind of have to accept what you can get. I gave it 4 stars because it's better than the average three star shtf book but I can't say that it's a really great one but it's very readable. Characters are not as well developed as I'd like and they don't seem like real people all the time. That's a tough skill for an author to learn.
