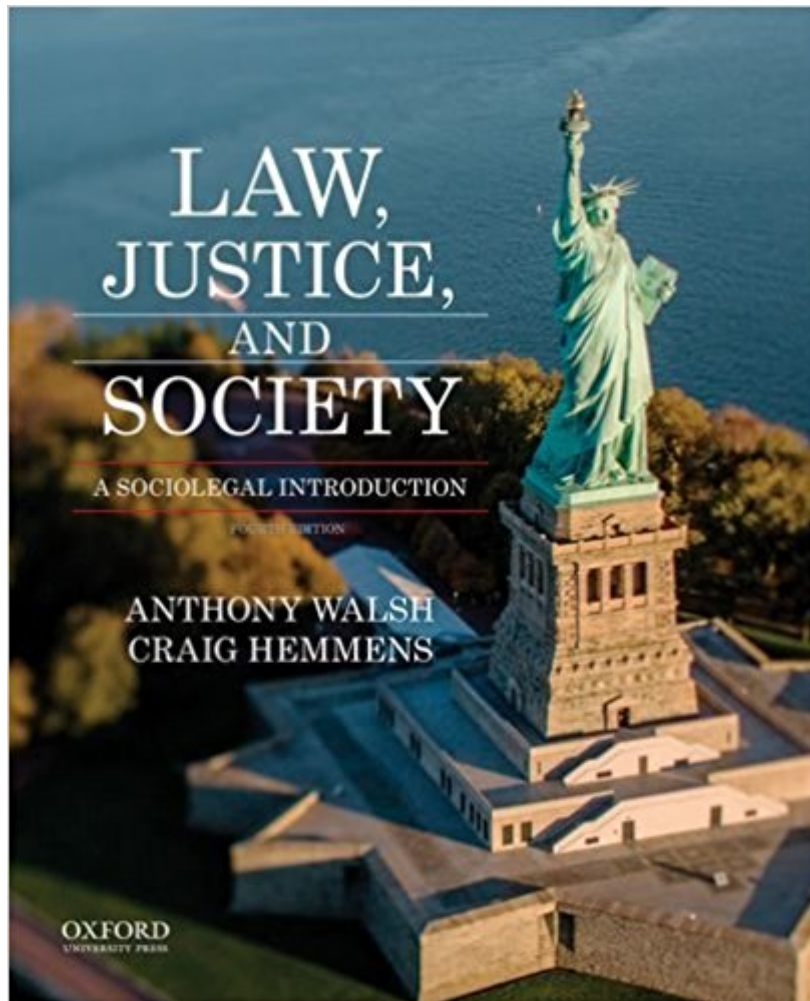


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Law, Justice, And Society: A Sociolegal Introduction
